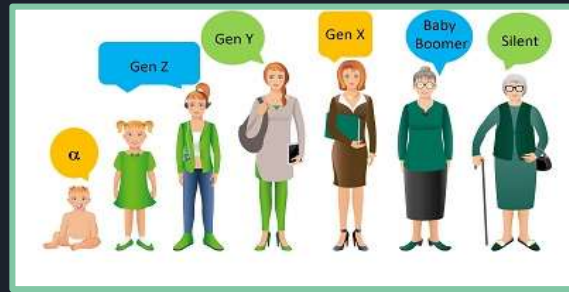

# Generations

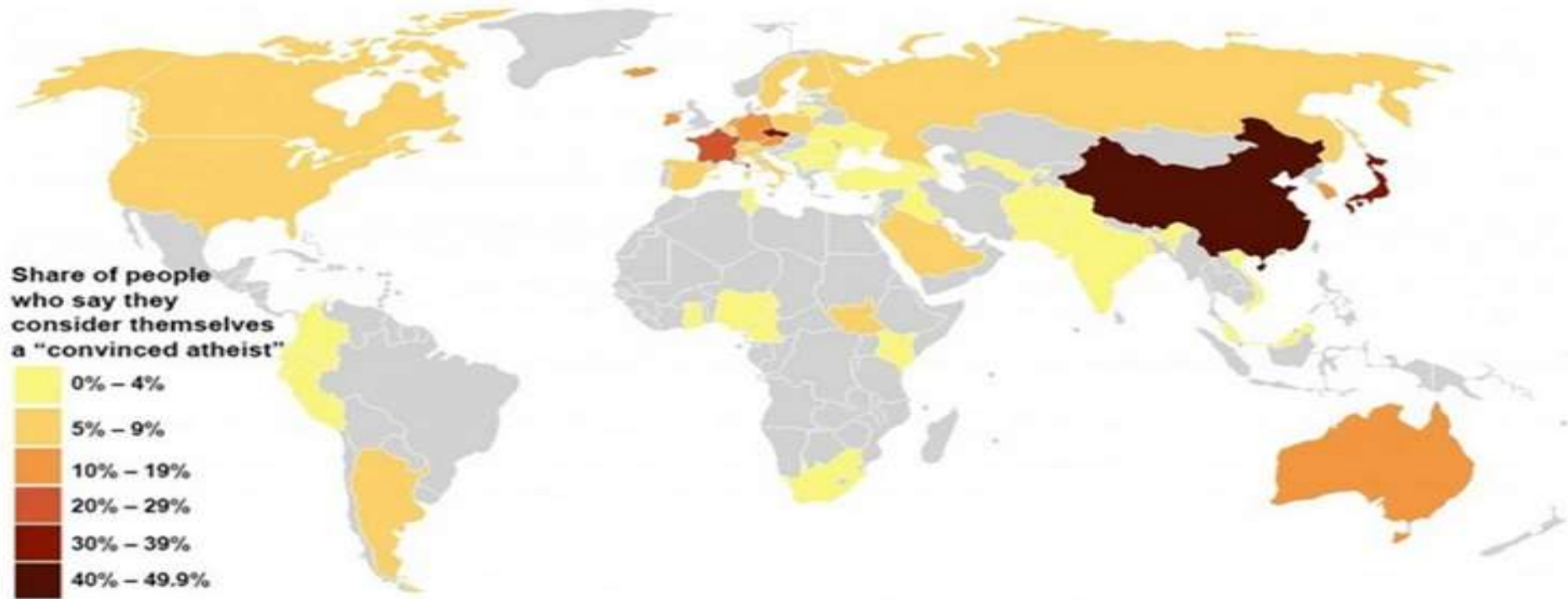
# SOCIAL FREEDOM
